# INSTALLING HARU STUCK-ON DESIGN

## Tools Required

**Box cutters** - If required, use with a cutter board.

**Metal Ruler** - For simple activities not requiring a completely clean edge.

**Scissors** - Best for installations and getting clean edges.

**Squeegee / Scraper** - Ensure all air bubbles are removed and the

tape is adhered smoothly.



## 6 POINTERS TO STICKING HARU STUCK-ON DESIGN EFFECTIVELY








Together with a partner, pull the tape taut/straight so no wrinkles form on the adhesive side.

This is especially important for large installations using wider rolls of HARU stuck-on design.



#### SMOOTH THINGS OUT! 2)




Removing air from underneath the tape is important. This will help make your art look neater and better.

Prevent air bubbles by using a squeegee to scrape outwards gently.

Start from the center of the tape width and **scrape** outwards at a 45 degree angle.



## **3) GETTING A CLEAN EDGE**




Over time, the adhesive material from HARU stuck-on design may build up, making the cutter less sharp.

### Using a blunt blade may lead to twisting or tearing of tape. Please remember to replace old blades

## 4) HORIZONTAL AND VERTICAL LINES




Try using guidelines when pasting HARU. Secure a piece of string on the wall as a guideline for horizontal lines. You can tie a weight at the end of the string for vertical lines to ensure it is straight.

To align a second strip, unravel the tape roll and **align the start and end points before pasting**. The first point to paste should be the **mid-point**, before scraping outwards.



#### TRANSLUCENTWASHI

HARU stuck on design (washi) allows layering of colors adding depth of artwork.

Great for filtered light effects.

#### POLYESTER MATERIALS

HARU stuck on design (PET) is great for floor use and is waterproof.

More durable than Washi tape.


#### HARU STUCK ON DESIGN

#### **GEOMETRIC PATTERNS**


HARU stuck on design (OPP) is simple and great on glass.


